Attached is a copy of the draft with my comments added.

The paper makes it clear that a great deal of technical work was done in support of the overall conclusions and I don't think any additional lab work is needed. At the same time, the biology parts of the paper often seem disorganized in ways that will interfere with a reader grasping the material being presented. My comments are detailed, with a mix of suggested fixes and questions for your consideration. The cryptocurrency parts of the paper were largely outside my ability to review.
